



The Hong Kong Cricket Club (“Muk Kau Wui” – Wooden Ball Club) is situated in the heart of Hong Kong Island, away from the hustle and bustle of the city. Although only a short distance from Central District, the Clubhouse and grounds enjoy a landmark verdant setting amongst the hills of Wongnaichung Gap. The Club offers sports opportunities and facilities coupled with superb dining outlets and a busy social events calendar – to the one side set against a backdrop of tree-covered slopes and to the other, an awe-inspiring view across Hong Kong Harbour and on to the “Nine Dragons” of Kowloon.

### ◆ Club Facilities

At a public meeting in June 1851, a proposal that a club be formed on the military parade ground south of the waterfront – the area to be turfed – launched one of the first cricket clubs outside England. One of its objects was “to promote the game of cricket, tennis, croquet and other athletic pastimes”. The Chater Road ground became the focal point of Central District in the City of Victoria. In 1975 the Club gave up its world-famous site and moved to the greener environment of The Gap.



Nowadays, Hong Kong Cricket Club’s grand tradition is combined with a family atmosphere. Cricket is still the Club’s *raison d’être*,

but league teams for Tennis, Squash, Lawn Bowls, Netball, Rugby and Hockey represent HKCC during their individual seasons.

The Sports Annexe building encompasses accommodation for activities and classes. An all-season 25-meter heated pool, together with Cafeteria, is situated to the eastern side of the Clubhouse.

The Club offers a superb range of cuisines in the four major Restaurants: a new Fine Wine & Dining area; soak up the family atmosphere in Spinners; enjoy the best of Chinese regional cuisine in The Willow Room; relax in the outdoor climate of The Sportsman’s Bar.

From Burns’ Supper in January right through to Christmas, the Club’s annual Social Calendar includes a busy schedule of events.

Our three Function Suites provide venues for private meetings and seminars, dinners, parties and gatherings of all sizes.

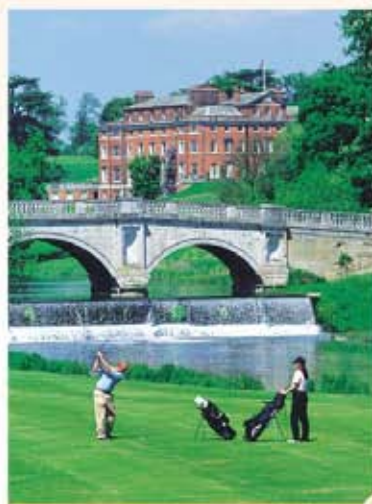
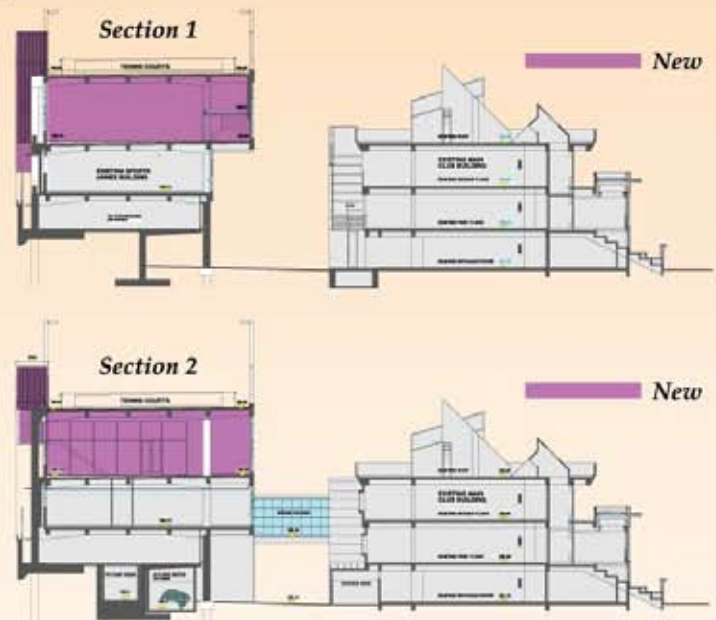
### ◆ Sports Annexe addition – Proposed Second Floor Cricketing Centre & Sports Hall :

Details: Planning Permission for Gross Floor Area of 1400 square meters with 6.8 meter ceiling height including an Indoor Sports Arena with state-of-the-art facilities.

Under Consideration: Bespoke Indoor Cricket Centre, Multi-Purpose Sports Hall for Indoor Sports and year-round training/practice, Relocation of Rooftop Tennis Courts, Toilet Facilities and Lift for Disabled access.
